

## WHAT IS THE OUTDOOR LAB?

The Phoebe Hall Knipling Outdoor Laboratory is a 226-acre facility in Fauquier County that provides a natural classroom for Arlington Public School (APS) students. It has a spring-fed stream, a pond, hiking trails, and an Animal Lab.

Annually, the Lab provides hands-on outdoor and environmental education to more than 10,000 APS students from elementary grades through high school.

The Outdoor Lab educational program is operated and staffed by APS, while the property is owned and managed by the nonprofit Arlington Outdoor Education Association (AOEA).



# WHAT IS OUTDOOR LAB CAMP?

The Outdoor Lab offers a week-long science enrichment camp that provides a number of nature-related activities and experiences to Arlington Public School students. Campers sleep outdoors in platform tents and are offered a variety of activities each day, including:

- Animal Exploration
- Boating & Fishing
- Night Walks
- Games & Skits
- Arts & Crafts
- Nature Hikes
- Survival Skills

Registration Opens @ 6 p.m. on Friday, March 3, 2023

Parents may apply for their student to attend camp by completing a short Google form (link will be activated at 6:00 p.m. on March 3, 2023). Applications will be accepted on a *first come-first served* basis until Friday, March 31, or until a session is full. Applications received after a session is full will be placed on the wait list.



Once a student has been accepted, the family will be sent an invoice for tuition. Payment is by check or money order.
